SOVIET OFFENSIVE AIMED AT LATIN AMERICA

WASHINGTON: Diplomatic sources reported the Soviet Union is pushing a bold new diplomatic trade offensive aimed at Latin America. They said that Russian Envoys are opposing any deals which would limit or inhibit Soviet trade with virtually all the countries of South and Central America. The Soviet Union has shown interest in commerce with the Latins through published statements and private assurances. The Kremlin wants to import raw materials and to export machinery equipment and possibly various kinds of semi-finished goods to Latin America. The Russians point to the Soviet-Brazil Trade Agreement under which the two countries exchange goods worth five million dollars in 1966 as an example of Russian good will.

PRESIDENT JOHNSON TALKS AT SUMMIT CONFERENCE

PUNTA DEL ESTE, URUGUAY: President Johnson told the Latin Americans to put differences aside and unite in a massive effort to cure economic ills. Ecuador accused the United States of short changing the hemisphere before the President spoke at the Summit Conference here. President of Ecuador, Otto Arosemena, said United States aid was inadequate to the hemisphere's needs for curbing social woes that attract Communism. Mr. Johnson also appealed to Latin America's youth to help shape their own destination. The Presidents qualified pledge of United States money and material to Latin American projects, ranging from a common market to the snipping of red tape climaxed the second day of the Summit Talks. The conference will end Friday with agreement on a blueprint for economic action, arms control and other actions.

NASHVILLE, TENN.: The Tennessee House voted to repeal the state's law which prohibits the teaching in public schools of any evolution theories conflicting with the Divine Creation of Man.

UNITED NATIONS: Syria warned the UN Security Council that any further attacks by Israel will lead to a larger battle no matter what the cost. Israel warned it will attack Syrian villagers who shoot across the line.

BANGKOK: Deputy Prime Minister Gen Propas Chulasapya said he was displeased with the off base behavior of some of the 37,000 American servicemen in Thailand.

SEOUL: South Korean Troops used artillery against a North Korean border patrol in the heaviest outbreak of fighting since 1953. North Korea blamed the United States for military provocation.

BONN, GER.: Former West German Chancellor Konrad Adenauer who is suffering from a grave illness was reported weakening Thursday night.

Division Championship.

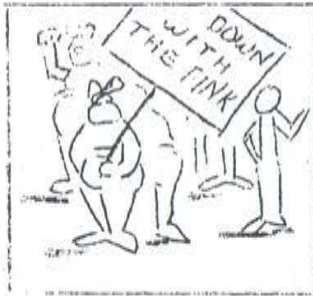
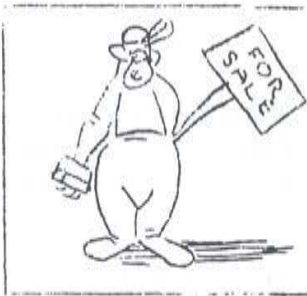
This was a well played game through-

Life at sea is new to the soldier. The Navy way of living is not akin to any- thing ashore. A Navy ship has its peculiar ities, a definite nomenclature, and in fact, a personality which sets it apart from all other vessels afloat. Become acquainted by observation. Assume that you are on the main deck facing the front (bow) of the ship; in this position every thing on the left is called the port side and everything on the right is called the starboard side. An easy way to remember these terms is the word "left" has four letters in it and so does the word "port". The station on the ship to which you will be assigned for the abandon ship drill or troop debarkation drill will be numbered. The even numbers are on the port side, and the odd numbers on the starboard side. The numbers start from the bow and go to the stern, so if you are assigned to debarkation station number two, you know that it is up forward and on the port side. The debarkation station assigned will usually be in close proximity to the berthing compartment in which you are located

USNS POPE: As everyone knows, there are various kinds of companies. There are companies of riflemen, companies of signalmen, companies of engineers and companies of players (theatrical). The 221st Signal Company (Pictorial), represented on board by its 1st Platoon, is a company of photographers.

The 221st is a new unit, organized under a new concept of photographic coverage and will be operating in the field for the first time when it reaches its destination. The company is made up of three platoons, one for each basic photographic activity, that is, still photography, motion picture photography and laboratory or processing. There are also administrative and support personnel within the platoon. Each platoon is further broken down into separate teams, each with its own officer and designed to be capable of prolonged operation detached from the company.

The first element to be deployed is the 1st Platoon, commanded by 1Lt Frank C. Lepore Jr., composed basically of 8 still photo teams. The motion picture and laboratory platoons will follow as they are equipped and trained on the new equipment. The company is being equipped with the latest equipment available, some even produced especially for the unit.

The Platoon Sergeant is Larry N. Motley, known affectionately as "Mother" Motley because of his concern for the troops in his care. He also is noted for his attention to detail, extreme patience and very soft voice.

The mission of the 221st is to provide photographic coverage of U.S. Army military operations wherever they may occur in the area to which they are headed. It is almost certain that many of the troops on board will be seeing them at work, and their work will be recording your work.

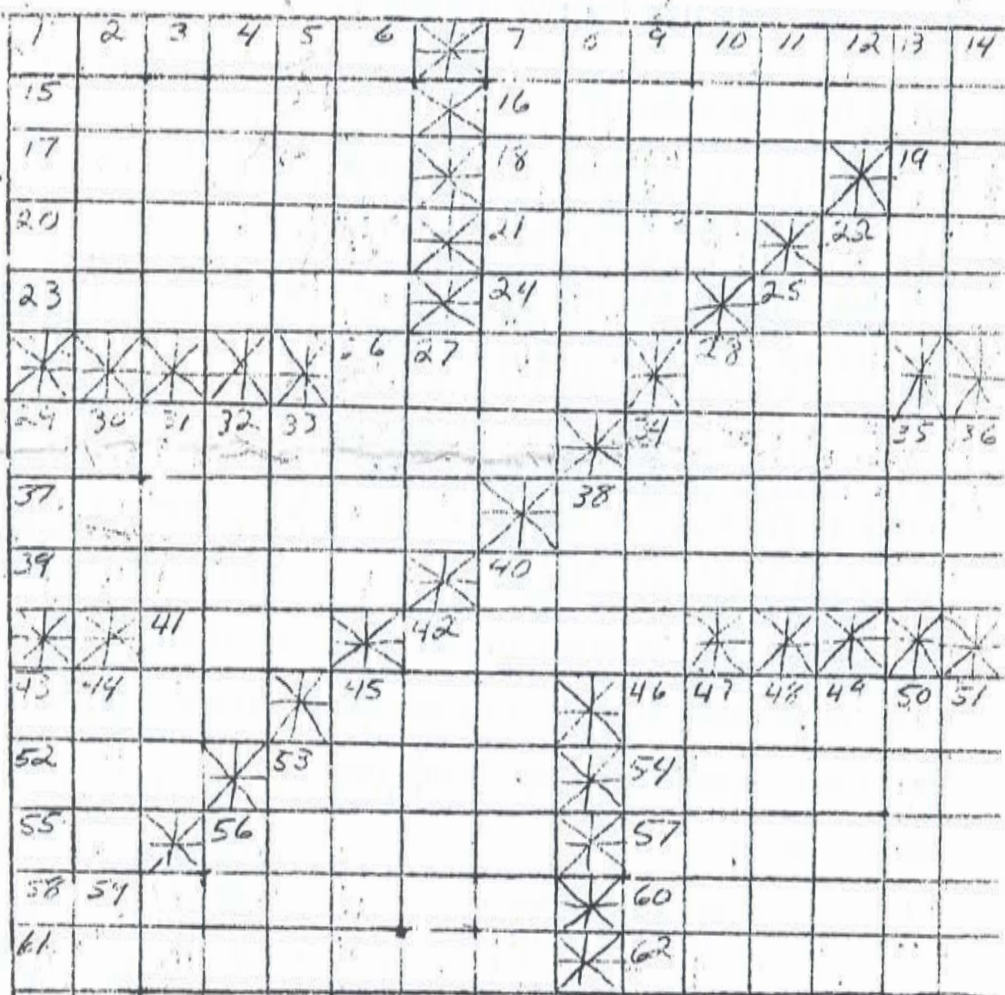
